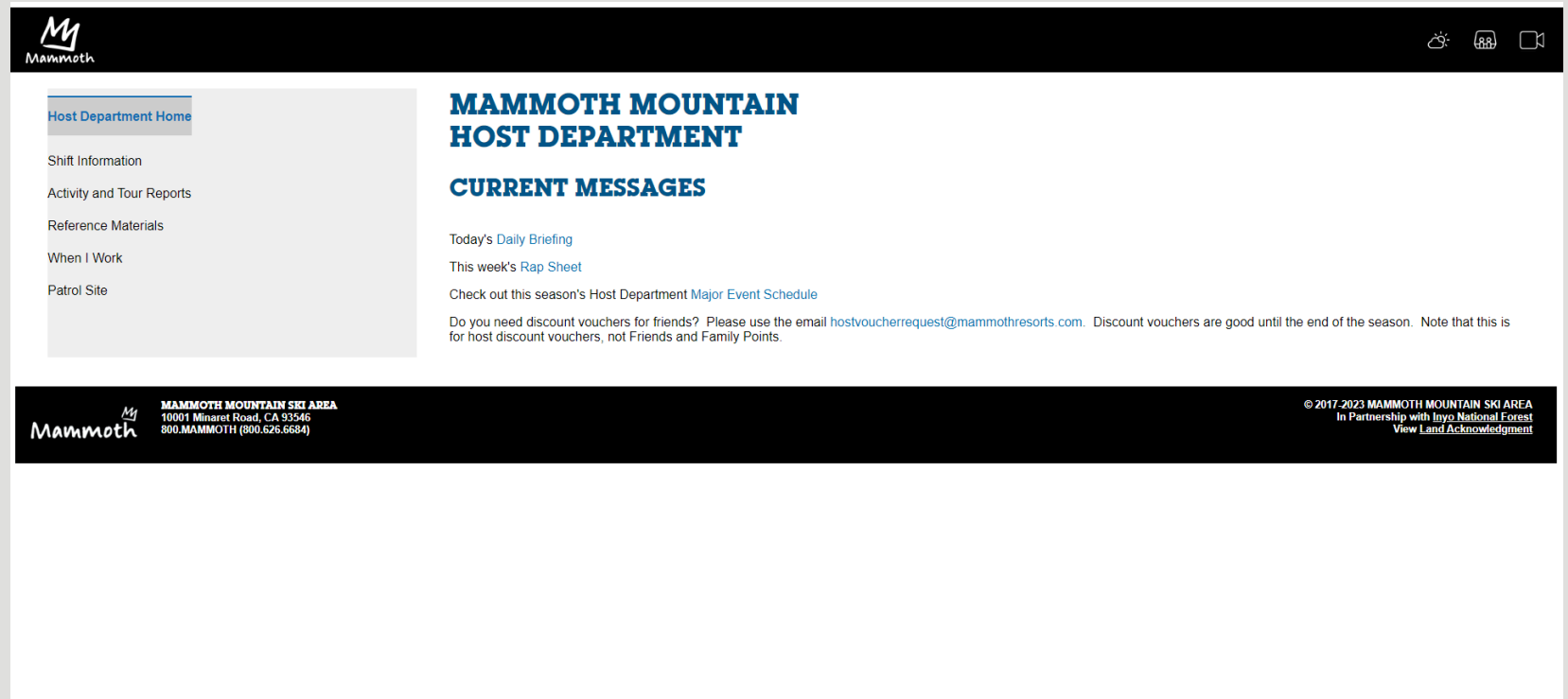

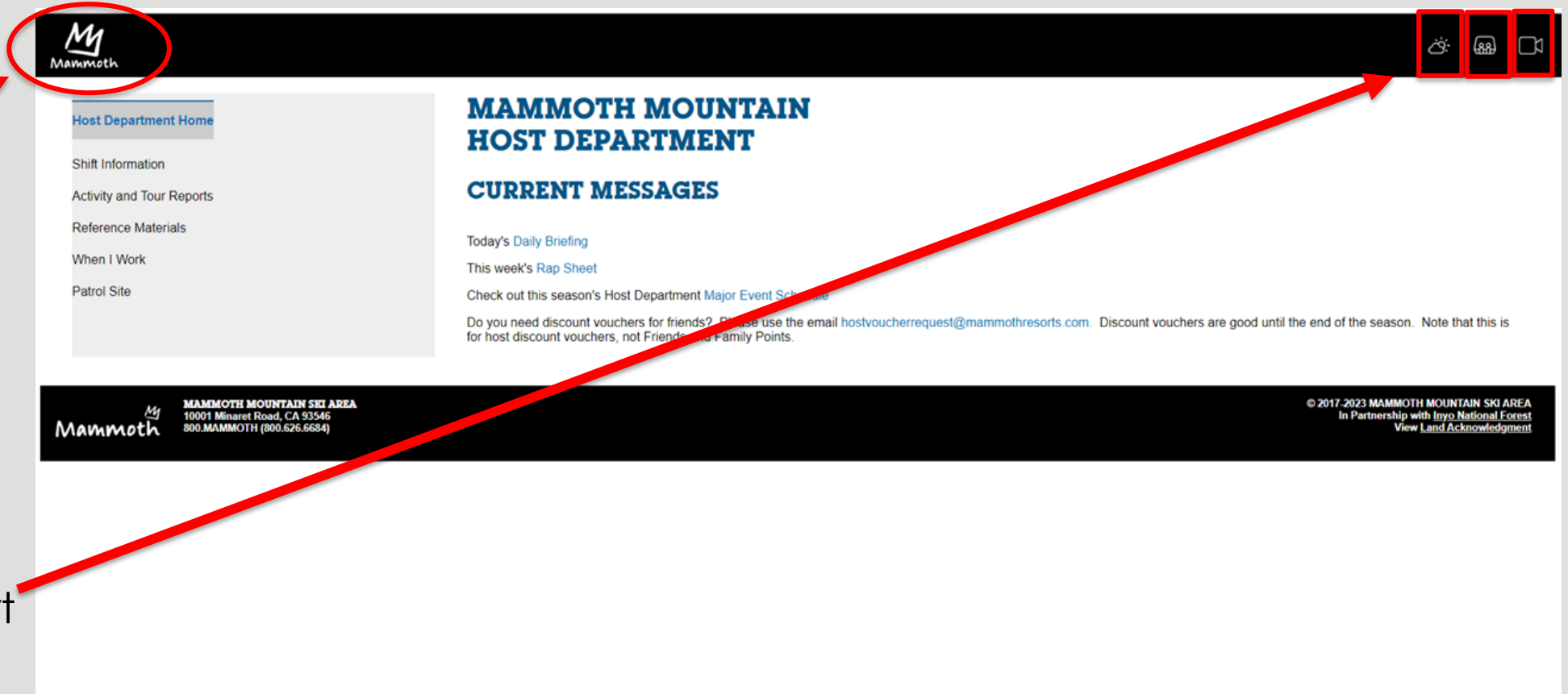

- Participate in ski and snowboarding preparation exercises and warm ups. Do not forget to stretch daily. If you have not started conditioning already, remember, it is never too late to start.
- Be prepared for winter driving – check your tire tread to be sure it is sufficient and put your chains in your vehicle by November 1. The law states you must have chains in your vehicle from November 1 until April 30 when you are traveling in any mountainous area in California. Remember it takes longer to stop on icy roads.
- Check your boots and your skis or snowboards, along with your other winter tools, to be sure they survived the spring and summer, are tuned, and are ready. Ensure your daily supplies are in your uniforms, as well as your nametags.
- Ski and Snowboard Hosts – if you had any surgery or injury to your lower extremities last year be prepared to take a Skill evaluation before you return to work in those roles. Sign up first to be a Lodge Host until you have been able to complete this test. Bring in a doctor's release stating you can return to skiing, unless it was covered by Workman's Compensation, MMSA will have already received that notice.
- As winter approaches, there are many animals getting ready too. Be sure to keep your car clean, and your home access locked. Visits from wild animals are dangerous.
