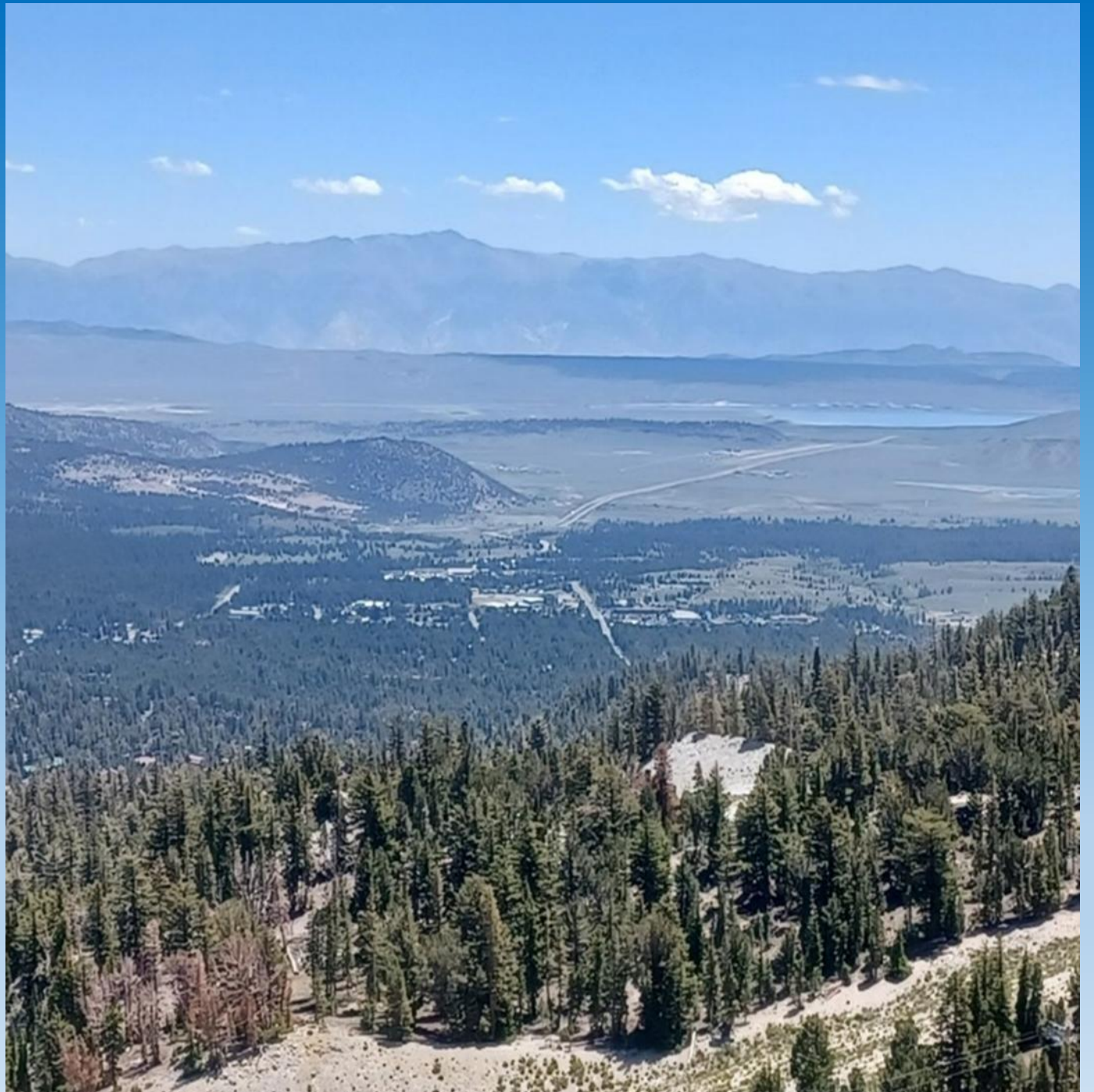


QMC (Information)
